# Specification

## **Product Description**

The T-Rax Heavy Duty Racking System is a storage solution suited for garages, warehouses, stock rooms and workshops.

This racking is made from heavy duty steel and is 100% bolt-less, making it easy to assemble and only requiring the use of a rubber mallet. Finished with four layers of powder coated painted this durable racking bay will maintain its excellent condition for even longer.

T-Rax are available in a range of sizes and colours providing something to suit every space and can even be halved to create two work benches or smaller shelves.

### **Item Contents**

A single T-Rax package includes: 8 L-shaped upright beams, 10 long beams, 10 short beams, 5 MDF boards, 4 beam connectors and 8 moulded feet. Please Note: Some T-Rax will also contain 5-10 central shelf supports.



- 1) L-shaped Upright Beam
- 2) Short Beam
- 3) MDF Board
- 4) Long Beam
- 5) Moulded Feet
- 6) Beam Connector



Please Note: Some T-Rax will also contain 5-10 central shelf supports.

## **Assembly Instructions**

- 1) Group parts together and lay them out on the floor.
- 2) Attach the 4 feet to the end of 4 L-shaped upright beams.
- 3) Take two of these L-shaped upright beams and attach a short beam across the bottom to connect the two, creating a U shape. Push the T-bar locking mechanisms into the slots on the upright and then hammer into place. Repeat this process on the other two upright beams.

**Please Note:** If the racking also has a central shelf support, please slot this before adding the MDF board for each shelf.



4) Repeat again with two long beams, this time across the front and back of the rack, connecting the two U shapes together. Make sure the beams that form each shelf are all level, otherwise your shelf will not be straight. **Please Note:** Please treat the MDF boards with varnish or mould prevention

products to prolong the life of the product.

5) Slot one MDF board into this metal shelf. Your first shelf is complete.



6) Repeat this process either side of the rack, first with two small beams for the sides then with two long beams for the front and back. Finally, slot another MDF board onto the second shelf.




7) Attach a beam connector to each of the upright corner beams. This is done in the same way as the other beams, push the T-bars into the slots and hammer into place.

8) To each of these connectors you are now able to attach the remaining 4 L-shaped upright beams.



- 9) Then continue to build the rest of the shelves, attaching the short beams at the side first, then the long beams at the front and back. Slot in each of the remaining MDF boards as you go.
- 10) Your T-Rax system should now be complete.



# **Troubleshooting**

### **Resolution Guide**

Please read through the guide below if you have any issues or faults with your T-Rax.

#### Q: There are parts missing from my order.

A: If there appears to be any part missing from your T-Rax package contact our Customer Support team via the details on the Contact page.

#### Q: The MDF has begun to warp or change shape.

A: Do not use this T-Rax for storage in a humid environment as the included MDF is untreated and is therefore susceptible to bend in an extremely damp or warm room. Other MDF can cut and used by the customer.

#### Q: What kind of tools should I use to assemble the T-Rax?

A: The only tools required to assemble a T-Rax racking bay is a rubber mallet, which are available to purchase through the Monster Shop website or via our Sales team, details available on the Contact page.

### Q: The T-bar locking mechanism on the long or short beams are bent or stick out from the slots on the upright beams.

A: Sometimes T-bar locks can be bent or stick out from the upright beams and will therefore not push into the slot fully. Separate the long or short beam from the upright. Take a screw driver and push it against the T-bar lock to bend the metal hooks until it is straight, and can fit into the slot on the upright beam.

#### Q: I'm worried the MDF shelves might grow mould in my garage.

A: We recommend you treat the MDF with mould prevention products. They are very accessible and cheap from good DIY stores.



# Safety Advice

### Safe Working Practice

Please read through the safe working practice to ensure prevention of injury or damage to the device.

Do not use the T-Rax in areas of high temperature or humidity as the MDF boards are untreated and may warp or become uneven.

Do not use corrosive cleaning equipment when cleaning your T-Rax as this may erode the paint.

Do not exceed the shelving capacities, detailed on the Specification page. Note- these capacities are based on the weight distributed across the whole shelf.

Always keep the weight evenly distributed to avoid damage to the rack or MDF and to prevent the rack from falling over.

Wear gloves when assembling this shelving to protect your hands.

Be careful when using a hammer to assemble these T-Rax.

Ensure that each beam is properly hammered into place before continuing with the assembly process.

Be sure that each MDF board is slotted into the shelf correctly before you begin storage on the racking.

Treat the MDF boards with varnish or mould prevention products if using in a humid environment.
