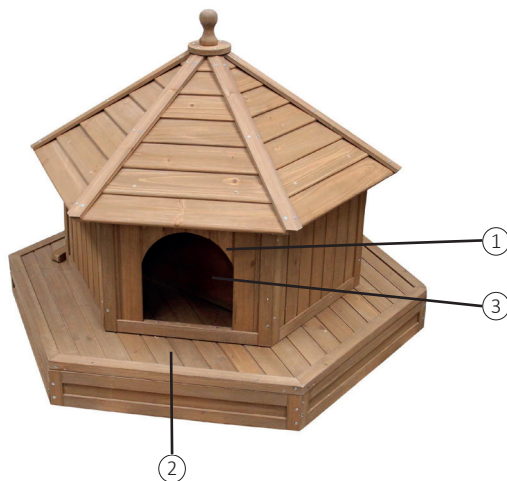

Assembly Instructions

If you are planning to paint your Duck House, we would recommend that you complete this prior to assembly to ensure an even coat.

We would also recommend that assembly is carried out on a flat and even surface.

1) Join all the platform side pieces together using the P3 screws. Ensure that the pieces are lined up in a way that the screws will not clash when secured through the pilot holes. Once joined these pieces should form a hexagon shape.

2) Attach the platform pieces to the top of the platform sides. Secure using P2 screws, screwed directly into the pre-drilled pilot holes. Although not necessary, for a smoother finish, you can secure the two platform pieces together using any screws you may have left over.

3) Join all the door and wall panels together using the P3 screws. The pattern should alternate doors and walls. The door and wall pieces which have the separator holders should face opposite each other.

4) Attach the Duck House walls to the platform. You should secure this by screwing the P2 screws into the pilot holes at the bottom of the doors.

5) Slide the compartment separators into their slots.

6) Attach the roof panels to the duck house using the P1 screws. Ensure that the pilot holes on the roof panel line up with the walls of the duck house and secure. Repeat with each panel.

7) Secure the roof planks. Place the roof planks onto the joins between each roof panel with the flat end at the top. Secure using the P5 screws.

8) Attach the decorative piece to the mount using 1 P3 screw. Attach this piece to the top of your Duck House using the P4 screws.

Maintenance

To ensure your ducks feel comfortable in their new home, we would not recommend any frequent cleaning as this may lead to your ducks rejecting their new habitat.

Cleaning once a year should be sufficient for ensuring the duck house remains in a usable condition. When cleaning, do not use chemical cleaners. Simply remove any dead bedding and replace with fresh, and wipe away any dirt that has accumulated.

Once a year the Duck House should also be re-treated to ensure it remains waterproof, preventing decay. The timber should be allowed to dry out thoroughly before allowing the ducks back inside to minimise exposure to fumes. Please check the guidelines on your chosen product for how long it will take to dry thoroughly. We also recommend that any products used are checked to ensure they are animal friendly.

Your Duck House should not need repairs for a long while after purchase due to its sturdy design and materials, however if you do find any damage, carry out repairs or replacement immediately to prevent further damage to your Duck House.

Please read through the guide below if you have any issues or faults with your device. The information covers and resolves the majority of frequently asked questions.

Q: There are parts missing from my order.

A: If there appears to be any part missing from your package contact our Customer Support team via the details on the Contact Us page within 7 days of receipt.

Q: My ducks aren't using the Duck House.

A: Ducks will be wary of any new habitation provided for them. The easiest way to warm your tame ducks to the house is to place the Duck House within their current habitation for a couple of days before placing on the water. During this time, occasionally place their food within the Duck House to encourage them to enter it. This way, they will be more inclined to use it once it is on the water. For wild ducks, simply ensure there is appropriate bedding inside and allow them time to become acclimatised to the new house.
