# SAFETY ADVICE

# SAFE WORKING PRACTICE

Please read through the safe working practice to ensure prevention of injury or damage to the device.

- Ensure the working area is well lit, clear and tidy, then keep unauthorized personnel at a safe distance.
- Do not store in areas of high temperature.
- Never store gas cylinders on the ground (earth), or in areas where water may accumulate.
- Ensure you store your cylinders vertically and securely to prevent toppling.
- Separate your cylinders appropriately, ensuring you keep flammable and oxidant gasses separate.
- Ensure the appropriate warning signs are visible.
- Never store LPG cylinders with other gas cylinders. LPG cylinders should be kept at a distance of 3 metres and/or separated by a firewall of at least 2 metre height.
- Store your cylinders in a well ventilated area, preferably outside on a dry and level surface.
- Keep the gas cage at least 4.5 metres away from dry vegetation or combustible materials.

This is not an exhaustive list of safety guidelines for storing Gas Cylinders. We strongly recommend you contact your Health & Safety advisor, local council or fire authority for further, specific information on how to conform to Health & Safety guidelines.

# ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Stand the Gas Cage and open so that all parts are easily moved.
- 2. Bend at the hinges so that a box shape is formed.
- 3. Pull the top panel up from inside the cage and place on top of the other parts. This should lock into place on the side panel with the fixed bolt.
- 4. Bolt to the floor where required using mounting bolts (not provided).
