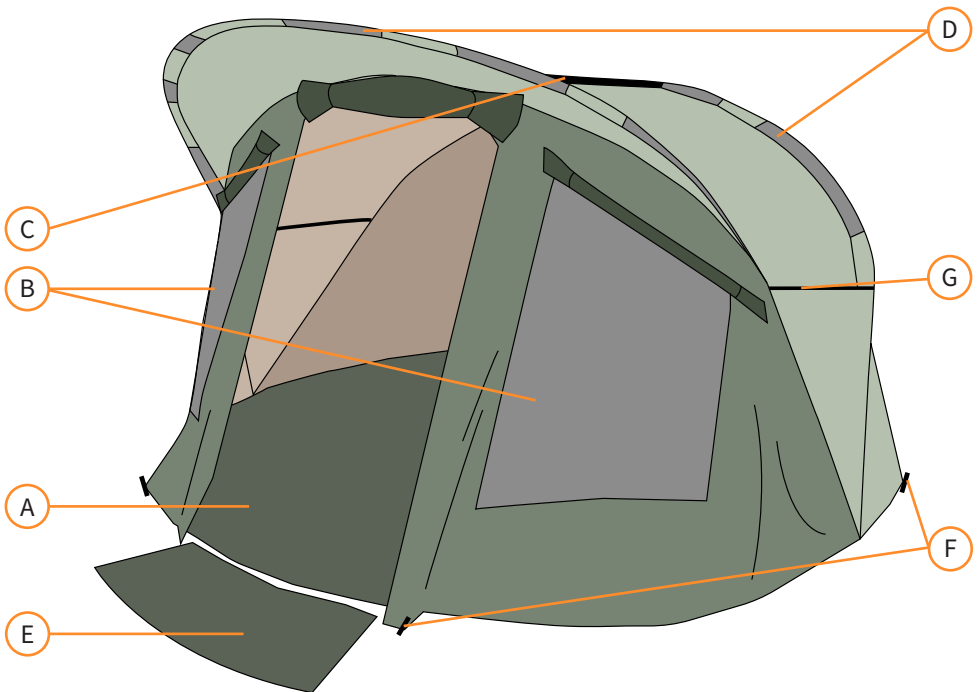

SAFE WORKING PRACTICE

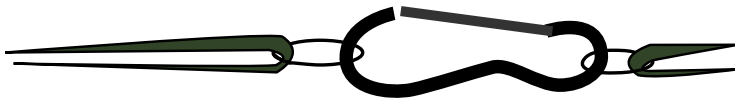
Please read through the Safe Working Practice to ensure prevention of injury or damage to the device.

- Do not use this product for anything other than its intended purposes.
- Ensure you have read and fully understood the instruction manual and safety advice before using this product.
- We would recommend two people work together to assemble the Bivvy.
- Take care when using the mallet to avoid injury.
- Do not use the Bivvy in extreme weather conditions, such as storms, electrical storms, high winds, etc.
- Do not leave the Bivvy unattended.
- Do not leave children unattended in and around the Bivvy.
- Take care when securing your fishing rod in the rod straps and ensure the velcro is pressed firmly down to avoid injury.
- Do not use the Bivvy without the required number of heavy-duty earth pegs. If you require more due to the loss of any, please see the troubleshooting section.

USER GUIDE

ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

1. Ensure you have each part that is needed to assemble the 2 Man Fishing Bivvy.
2. Choose a suitable place to erect your bivvy and lay the groundsheet out in its place.
3. Unfold the Bivvy and connect each of the preinstalled poles in the fabric (**D**) together. There are 3 poles in total.
4. Take the long webbing tensioning strap and hook it on to the D Ring of the opposite side of the Bivvy. This will slightly bend the poles to ensure the correct tension.



5. Lift the Bivvy up and position it over the ground sheet.
6. Take 1 extendable tension bar (**C**) and clip it on to the center of the back of the Bivvy. Now take another tension bar (**C**) and clip this in between the two poles in the center of the Bivvy roof. Then take the last tension bar (**C**) and clip it to the front of the Bivvy to straighten out the overhang.
7. Now you can extend the first two bars so that the Bivvy material is taut by unclipping the lock until it reaches the perfect length. The last bar should have the spike firmly in the ground to give the Bivvy stability.
8. Using the heavy-duty earth pegs and mallet provided, start to peg down the Bivvy. We recommend that you begin at the Bivvy door and work your way round to the back.

9. Now take the two side support bars (**G**) and clip them in at either side of the Bivvy between the poles. This is to give your Bivvy additional protection against higher winds.
10. To ensure a waterproof seal, tuck the Bivvy skirt underneath the groundsheet from the inside of the Bivvy. Secure it in place by using the hook and loop fastening.
11. To fit the PVC Window, roll up the window cover on the closed door and secure with the toggle and loops. Line up the PVC Window with the hook and loop fastening on the door window and push down to secure.

OPTIONAL BIVVY OVERWRAP

1. Open up the Overwrap and place it over the Bivvy, taking care to line up the door with the door of the Bivvy.
2. Now use the heavy-duty earth pegs and peg down the Overwrap securely into the ground.
