When climbing the stairs it's always handy to have a handrail. Our handrails are quick and easy to assemble, and include a range of fixtures depending on the size of rail you've ordered.

The handrail connectors allow the handrail to snake around corners, meaning the handrail can be fitted to any wall.

Sizes include:

- 1.5 meter 42mm
- 2 meters 42mm
- 3 meters 42mm
- 3.5 meters 42mm
- 4 meters 42mm

We know you've only got one pair of hands so it's best to grab a friend, neighbour or colleague when assembling the handrail and brackets.

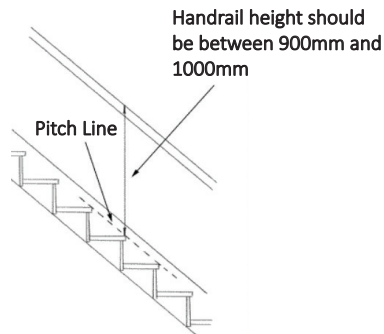

Step 1- How high should I fit my handrail?

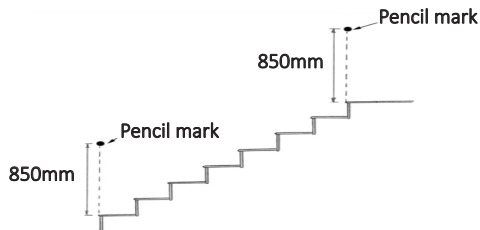
Handrail heights should be between 900mm and 1000mm measured from the pitch line to the top of the handrail.

- 1) Lay a straight edge, long enough to cover several steps, on the stairs. The pitch line will be the underside of the straight edge (assuming that no carpets are fitted). See image below.



Step 2- Installing the handrail

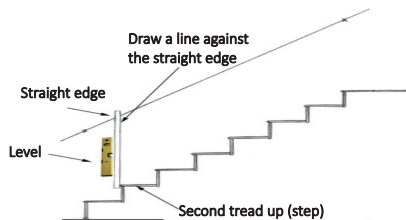
- 1) Allow 50mm for the thickness of the handrail, measure up vertically at least 850mm from the front of the bottom tread (step), and the front of the top tread (step). See image below.



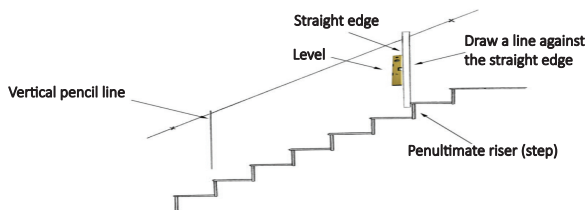

- 2) Mark these points with a pencil.
- 3) Grab two friends to help you with this next step.
Have two people hold a string taut between these two points.
- 4) Mark on the wall every 500mm or so.
- 5) Place a long straight edge against every marked point until you get a vertical line.
- 6) Draw a pencil line against the straight edge once you are happy with the height and placement.
- 7) Place a long straight edge and level against the second riser to mark an intersecting vertical line. See image below.



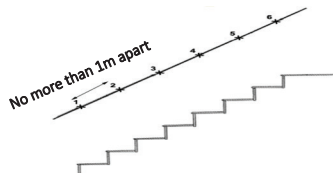
- 8) Repeat (7) until you reach the penultimate riser. See image below.

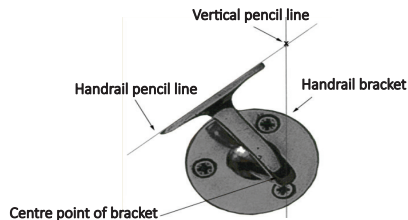

- 9) You will now have marked positions for your hand rail brackets. Make sure that the brackets are no further than 1m apart. It is normal to have two more points in total than needed. See image below.



Step 3- Installing the handrail brackets

- 1) Place the first bracket against the wall with the centre line of the bracket against the vertical line and the handrail plate along the handrail pencil line. See image below for guidance.



- 2) Mark the three screw holes with a pencil and then remove the bracket.
- 3) Repeat this process for the remaining brackets.
- 4) Fix the brackets to the wall using the appropriate fixings (not provided).

Please make sure you have a secure fixing before fixing the rail to the handrail.

Step 4- Placing the handrail

- 1) With the help of a friend, place the handrail on the brackets and mark the position of the fixing holes. This will allow you to pre-drill your handrail.
- 2) Drill the 4 pilot holes.
- 3) Screw in 4 screws, through the handrail bracket and into the handrail.
- 4) Once screws are tight, your handrail is finished and ready to use.

Please read through the guide below if you have any issues or faults with your product. The information covers and resolves the majority of frequently asked questions.

Q: There are parts missing from my order.

Q: What kind of tools should I use to assemble the handrail?

A: A drill will be needed when fixing the handrail bracket to the wall and/or to the the rail itself. A screwdriver suitable for crosshead screws.

Q: How do I maintain the stainless steel handrails?

A: Stainless steel is one of the most durable options for a handrail. However it will still require some maintenance in order to sustain its initial appearance. Depending on the location and application depends how much cleaning the handrail will need. A mild detergent cleaner will remove anything that may affect the durability and/or appearance of the stainless steel. Glass cleaner will help to get rid of any stubborn fingerprints.

Safe Working Practice

Please read through the safe working practice to ensure prevention of injury or damage to you or the product.

Do not assemble the handrail and brackets if they are damaged and/or broken.

The handrails are quite heavy and should be handled carefully.

Only place the handrail and brackets in a suitable area/space.

Use eye protection when using tools such as a drill.

Ensure loose clothing and hair is tucked away when using a drill.

Make sure the handrail brackets are secure before continuing with assembly.

Be careful when working on stairs.
