Waste Kit Assembly

Thank you for purchasing this sink from Monster Chef. Please follow these simple instructions for assembling your free waste kit. Note: this is a generic waste kit designed to fit to most domestic UK pipes.



Slot a nut and washer onto the threaded end of the long elbow. Attach the long elbow to the T-piece, using the nut to secure the two together.

The short elbow piece should come with nut already attached, slot a washer onto the end of this short elbow piece and secure to the bottom of the T-piece.

Both medium elbows should also come complete with nuts already attached. Slot a washer onto both of the threaded ends of these elbows, then use the attached nuts to secure one to the top of the long elbow and one to the top of the T-piece.

Attach a nut to the top of the short elbow and slot a washer into the top (as shown). Secure the main bowl plug hole to the short elbow using the nut.

The overflow waste pipe may need trimming to suit your requirements, the end can simply be cut in order to provide a smooth transit from overflow to waste.

The smallest nut will fit onto the end of the pipe and the small black washer should slot on afterwards. Use the nut to secure the overflow pipe to the main bowl plug hole.

Attach the final nut to the top of the left hand short elbow and slot a washer into the top (as shown). Secure the half bowl plug hole to short elbow, using the nut to secure it in place.
